



Making Your NOAA CFC Pledge Is As Easy As 1-2-3

1. **Go to <http://www.cfc.noaa.gov>:** Learn about the CFC and access our e-giving tools. Click on the **Catalog of Caring** to view descriptions of the over 4,000 charities, or click on **Online Charity Search** to search the database of charities to find those that fit your interests and passions. Make sure to note the CFC five-digit code number of your desired charities.
2. **Choose your method of pledging:** Please see the chart below and find the option that works best for you.
3. **Turn in your forms or notify your Keyworker:** If required, turn in your pledge forms, and if no, inform your NOAA CFC Keyworker for recognition, including Eagle and Double Eagle Donor levels. Remember, **December 15th** is the final day for donations. That's it!
