LOCATION:

Rod 'N' Reel Marina, 4165 Mears Avenue, Chesapeake Beach, MD (1 hour east of DC)

PRICE: \$150 per person (\$55 of which we are recommending goes to CFC)

FORMAT & PRIZES:

Teams of at least 8 people (individuals can be grouped with teams) will be paired with a charter boat to fish from 6am to 12pm. Prizes will be awarded to teams that have the most catch (in number), biggest fish in length, and biggest fish in weight. Fish can be kept or released, up to the individual.

WHAT IS SUPPLIED

Fishing licenses are covered by the charter boat. Fishing gear and measuring boards are also provided by the charter boat. The coordinators will be providing each boat with a scale to weigh the fish.

WHAT IS NEEDED

All you need to bring are some warm clothes, drinks, snacks, and a camera!

NOAA's CFC Charter Boat Fishing Challenge Hosted by NOAA Fisheries

Come support CFC while fishing for striped bass and other fish on the Chesapeake Bay! This CFC event is hosted by NOAA Fisheries, but open to all NOAA employees and their families. This is a charter boat fishing challenge, so the only thing you bring is yourself, no fishing license or tackle needed. Just come on down, catch a lot of fish and if your team catches the most, longest, or heaviest fish, you win a prize!

The tournament will begin at 6am and ends at 12pm. Once everyone is back we will announce the winners and we can socialize at one of the marinas restaurants afterwards to tell our fish tales!

The registration fee is \$150, of which \$90 pays for the charter service and \$5 for prizes. The remainder of the earnings (\$55 per person) will be donated to the CFC Undesignated Fund.
