TOURNAMENT FORMAT

Scramble—all golfers play as part of a four-person team. At the 3pm shotgun start, teams tee off at each of the 9 holes; the best of the tee shots is selected by the team and everyone on the team plays their second shot from that spot. The best of the second shots is determined, and so on, until the ball is holed.

PRIZES

The team with the lowest score, and individuals with the longest drive or closest to the hole win prizes and get to donate the tournament earnings to the CFC general fund in their teams name.

BBQ DINNER

Catered BBQ including pulled pork, homemade smoked sausage, smoked grilled chicken, baked beans, potato salad, and green beans.
